**MAIN OBJECTIVE:**

Collaborate to improve, homogenize and develop the teaching and learning of French in Thailand in accordance with international standards.

Propose joint projects to motivate and reward teachers and students of French in Thailand.

**PROPOSED PROJECTS TO ATTAIN THIS OBJECTIVE:**

1. **Scholarships awarded by the French Embassy** for study trips in France, for the laureates of national contests (student and teacher categories – secondary schools and universities)
2. **Implementation of the DELF/DALF as an official evaluation tool for teachers and students** (DELF/DALF = internationally recognized French proficiency test delivered by the French Ministry of Education, consistent with the Common European Framework of Reference for Language)
3. **Teacher training plan** (including specific programs for new teachers): regular workshops throughout the country and a national training seminar presented by experts invited by the French Embassy or organized by the French department of universities with the support of the Embassy.
4. **Bilingual programs** in elite science schools (Phitsanulok)
5. **Local, national and regional language camps** for students.
6. **Study trip in France** for school directors hosting a French Development Center
7. **French fairs**
